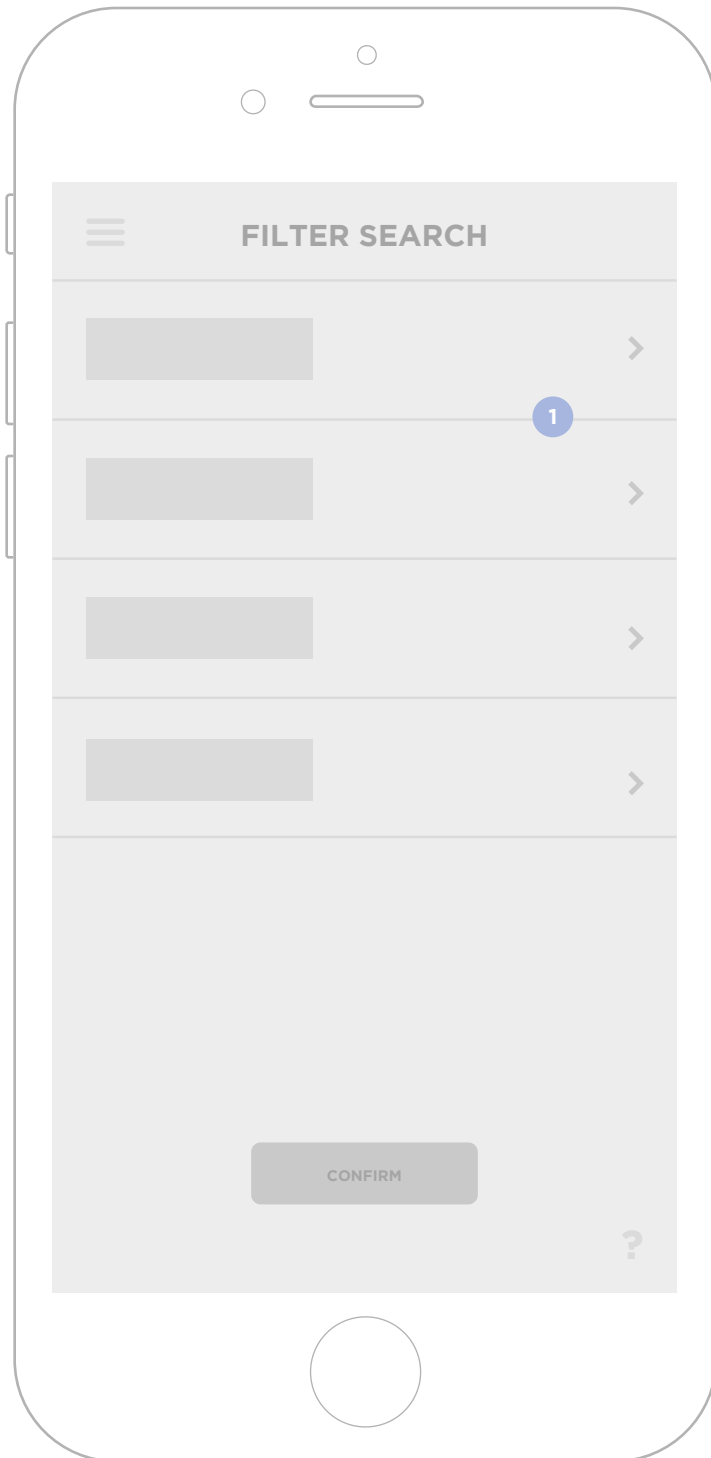
Most recent dogs are listed

- 1 The user can add a dog he likes to their “Favorite list” by tapping the like button.
- 2 The user can share a dog to social media, if the user knows someone that might adopt the dog is an easy way to share it with that person.
- 3 Basic information about the dog.

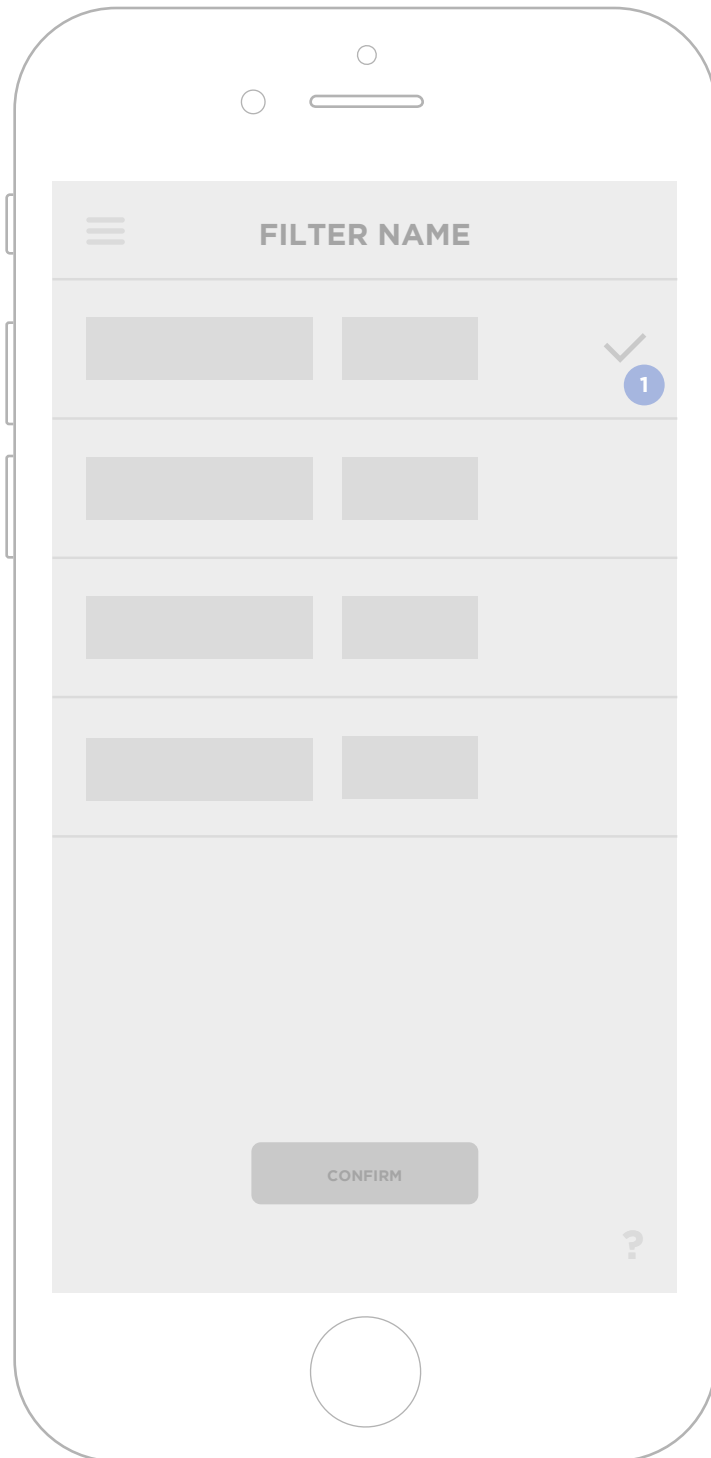
If the user wants to know more, he can click on the picture or info and the profile appears on the screen with more detailed information.



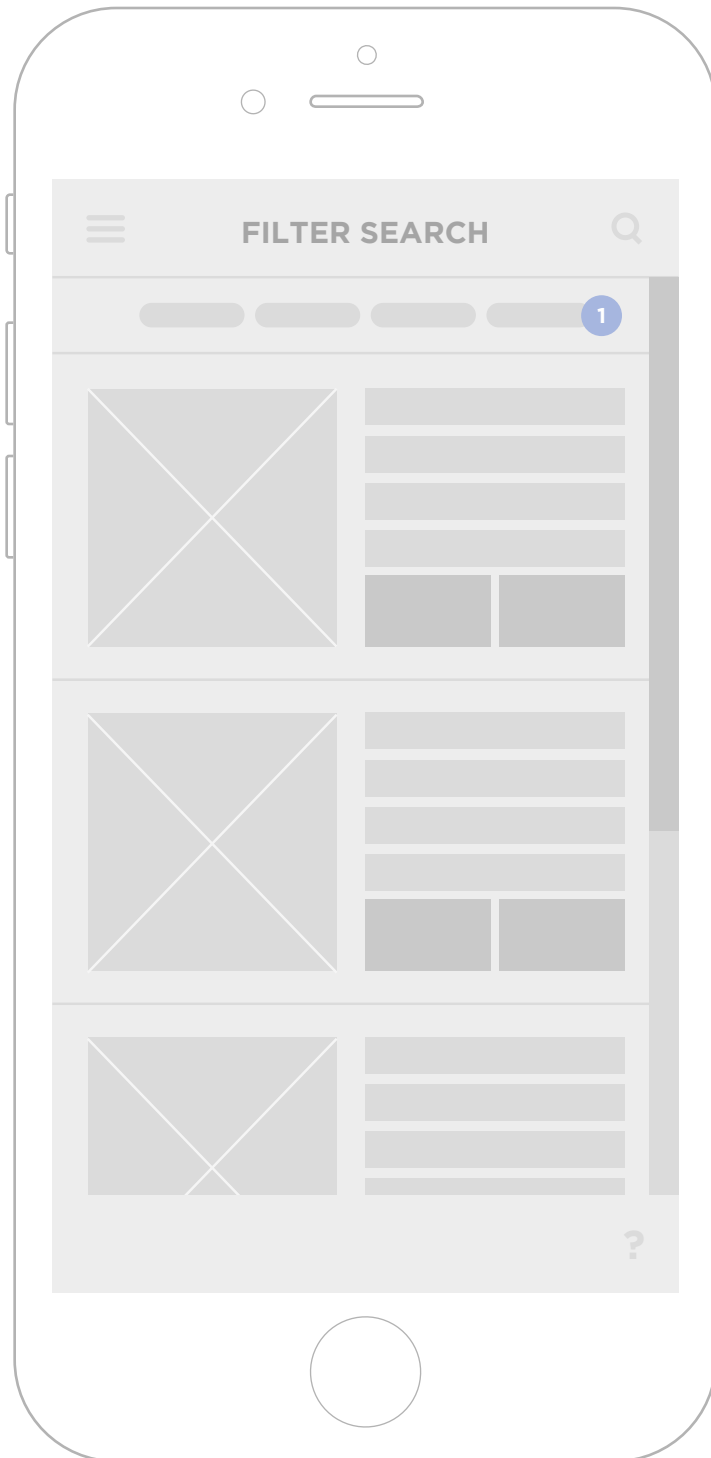
- 1 Pictures of the dog

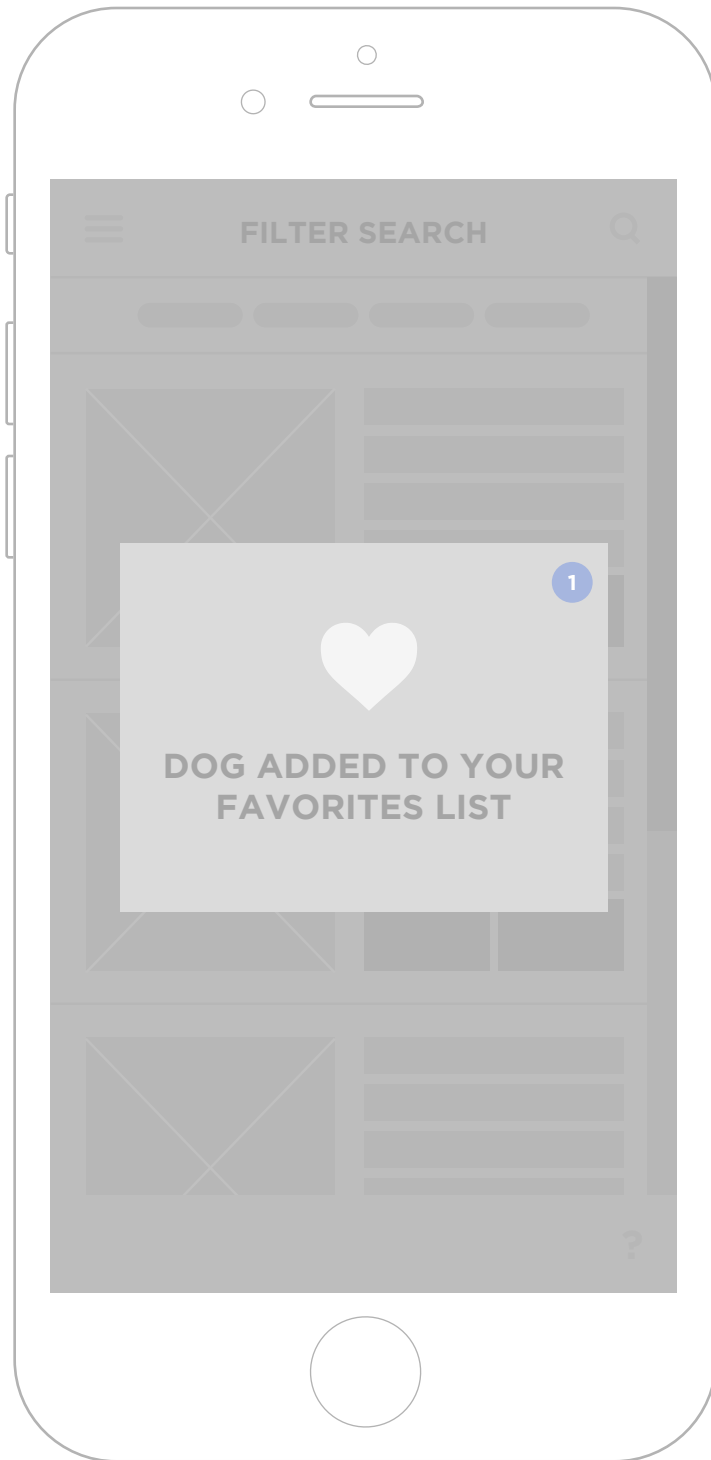
- 1 User can filter search results by:

  - Popularity (number of likes)



- 1 Selection of filter category.  
Click and goes back to Filter Search screen.

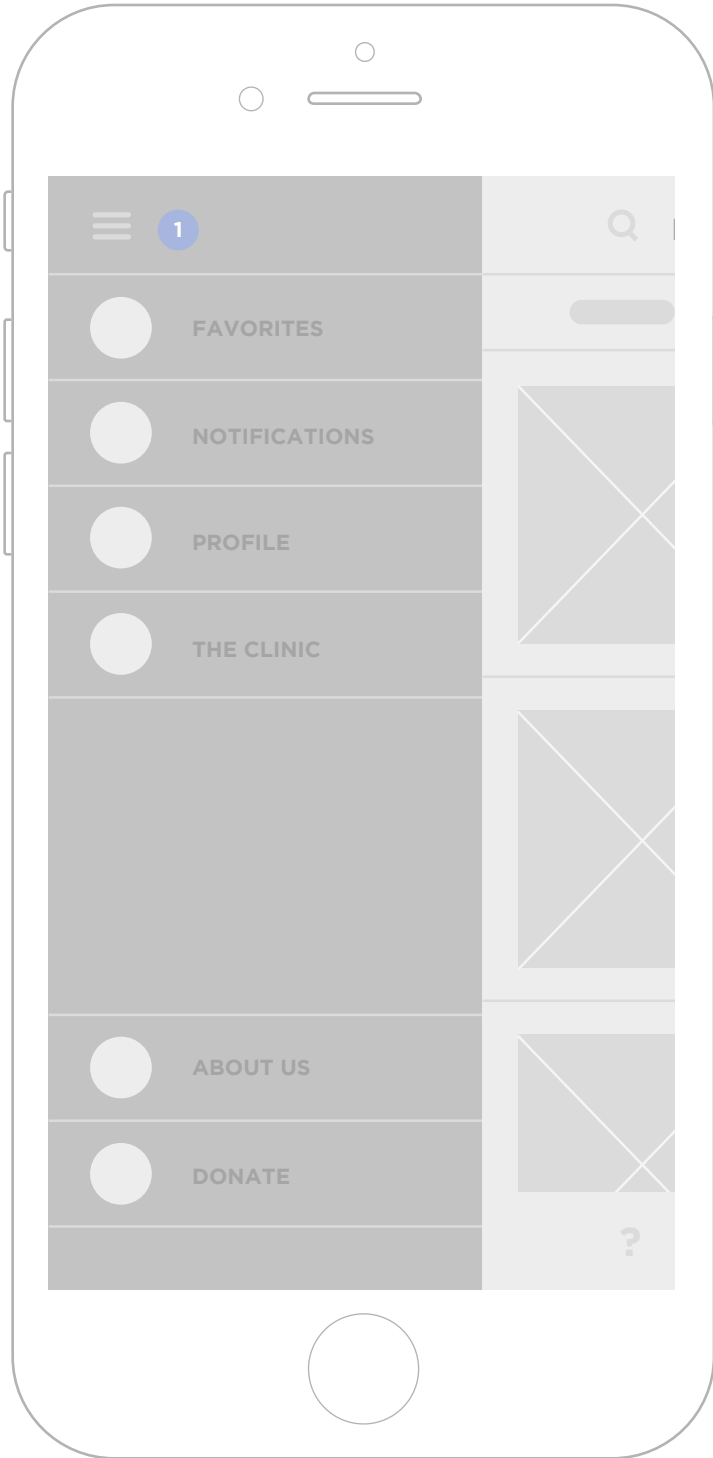


- 1 Filters tags are shown on top of the list so the user knows these are dogs meeting his desires.



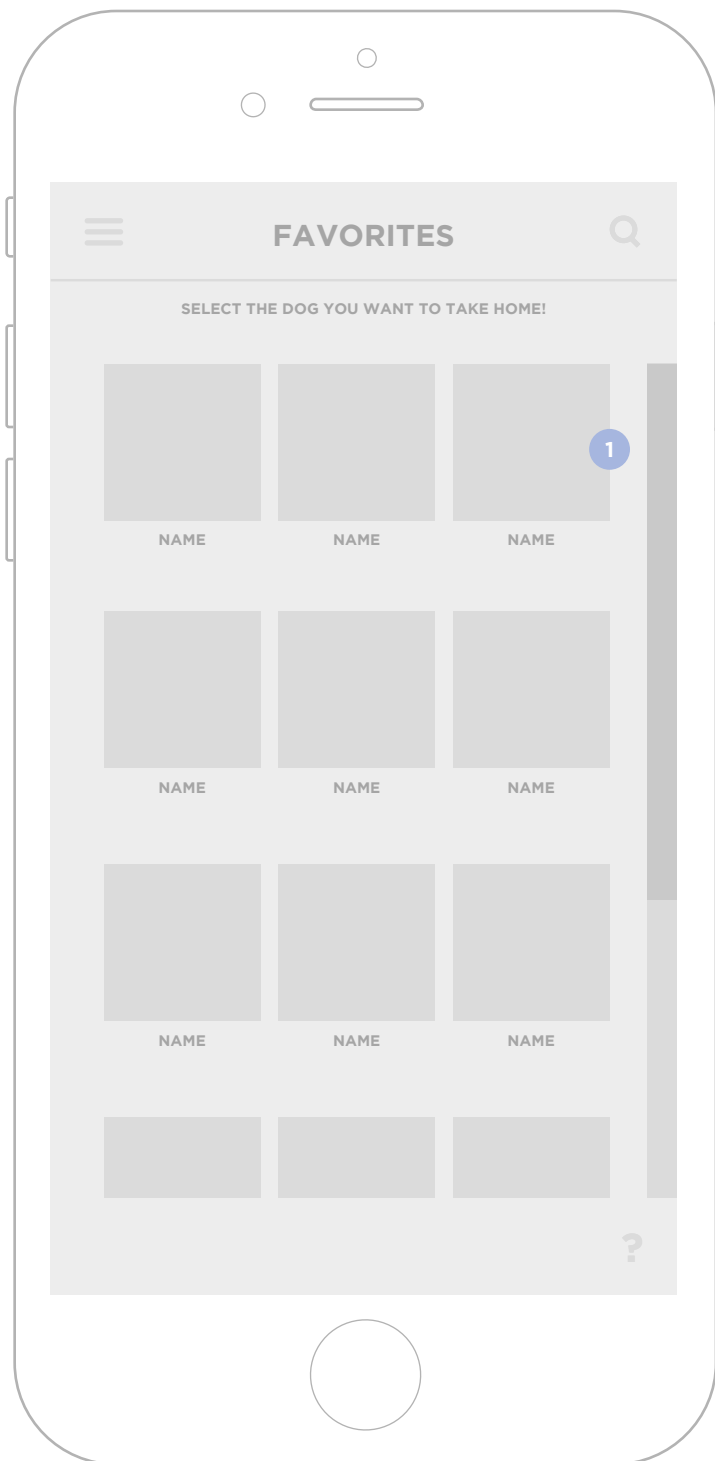
- 1 A window appears the first time an user taps the like button letting them know they can find their favorite dogs in the Favorites list section. (Goes away on it's own).





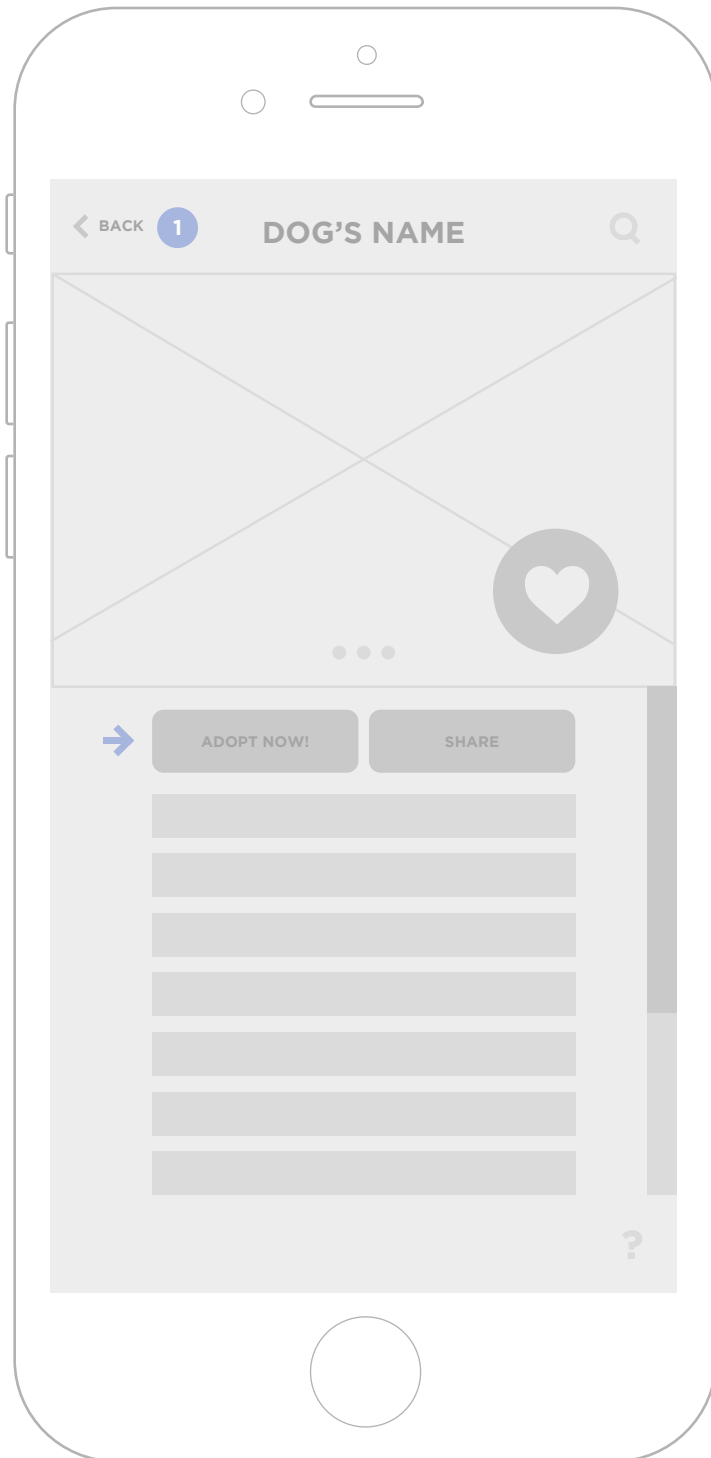
1 Menu sections

Menu can be accessed by the menu button or by swiping from the leftside of the screen.



1 Pictures and names of liked dogs.

If you click on it, it goes back to dog's profile, this way the user can see the dog's information before making a decision.



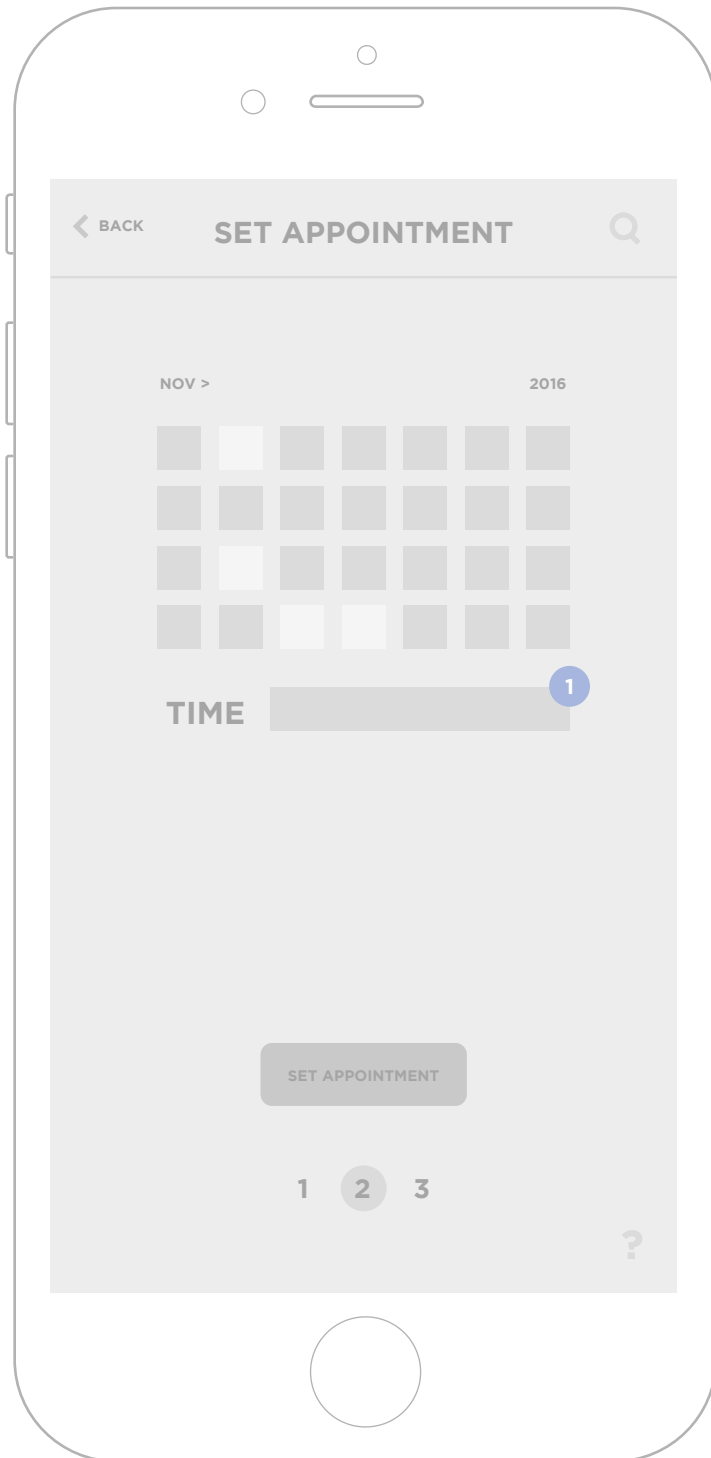
1 User can go back to favorites list.

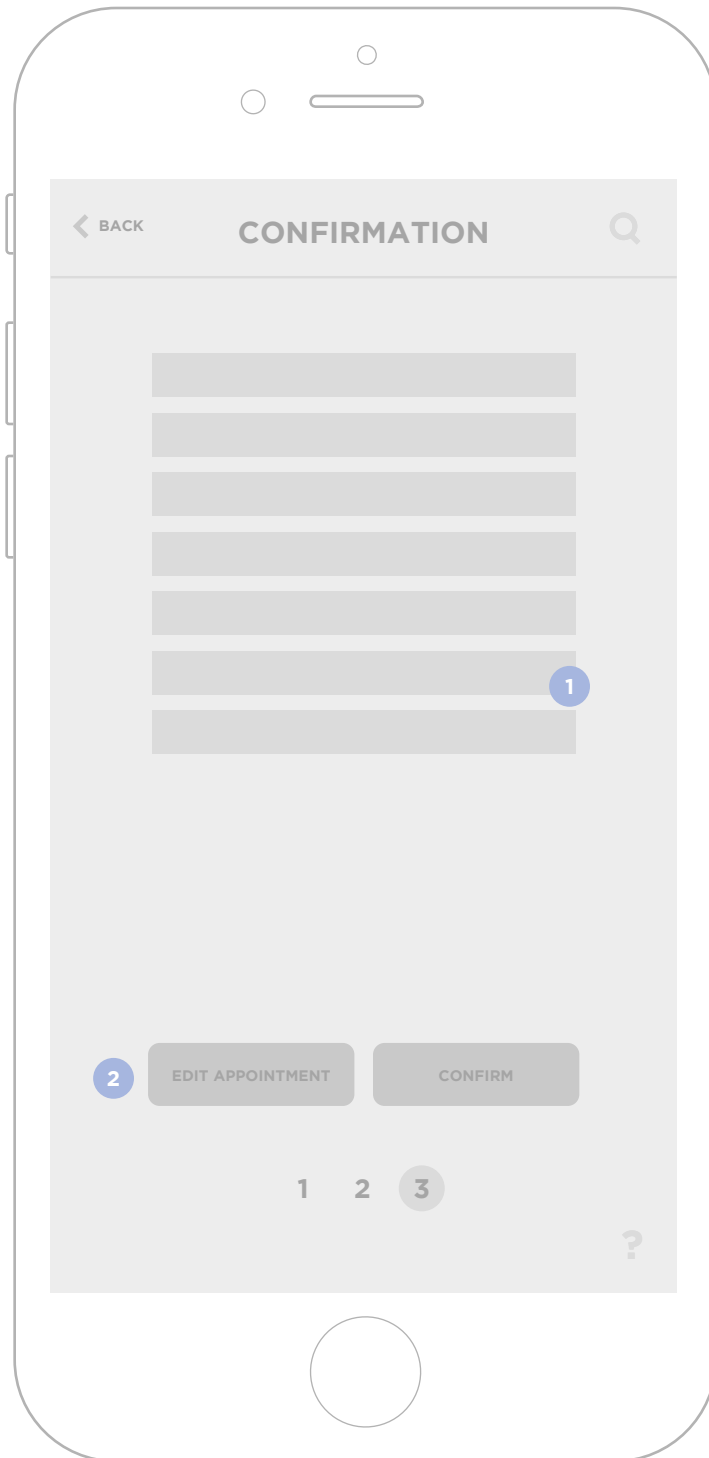
1 User information is auto filled from user's profile, user can check if there is any incorrect information and edit it.

3 Steps are shown in the bottom of the screen. This way the user knows where he is and knows how many steps are left.

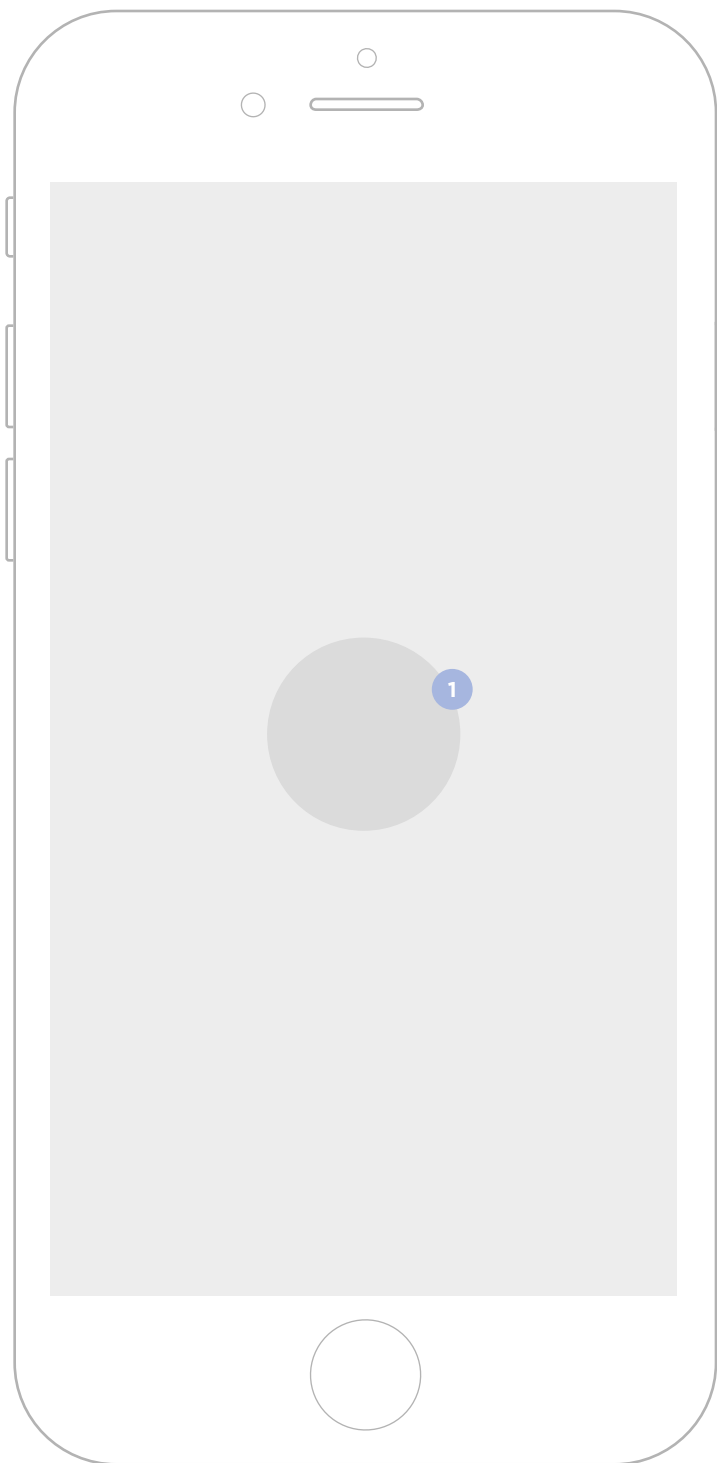


- 1 User can select an available date and time to set an appointment with the dog.

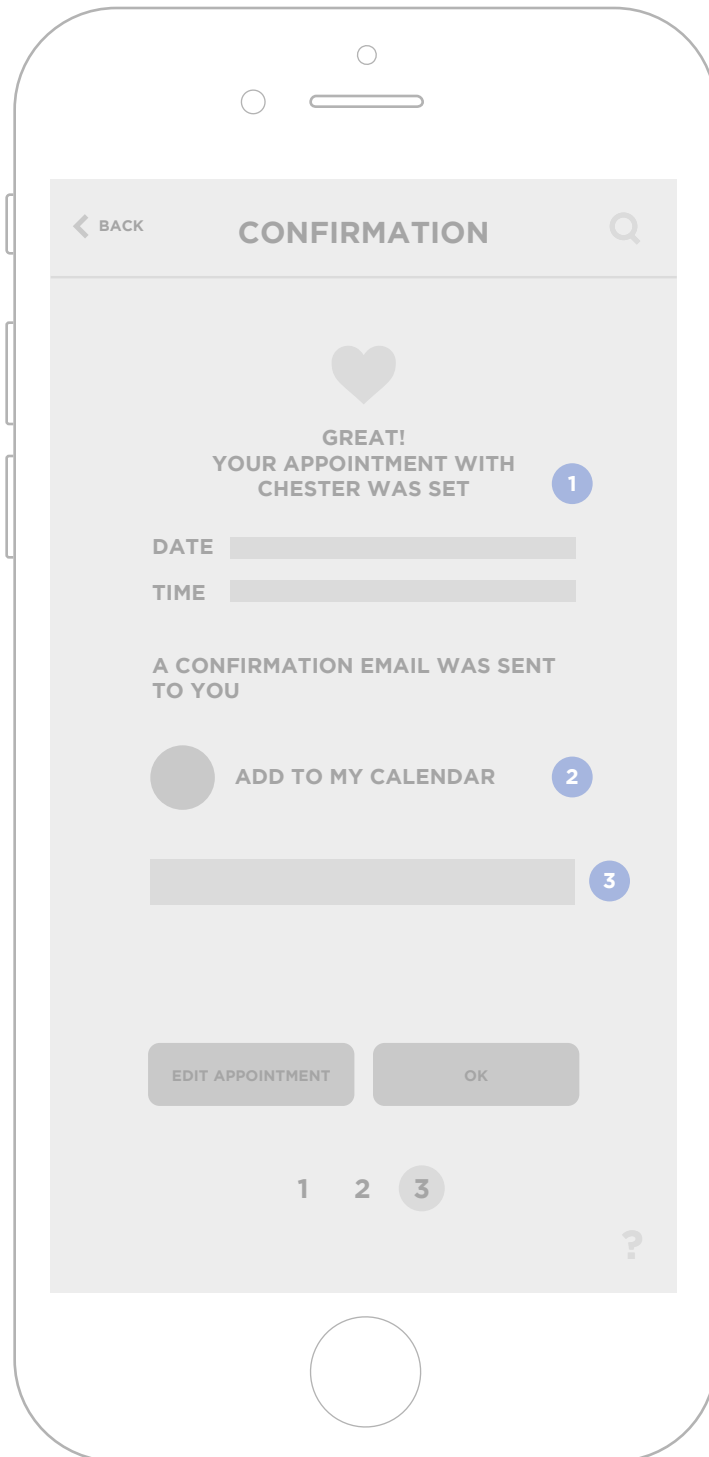


- 1 Confirmation info has the following:

- 1 Animation of dog's paws.



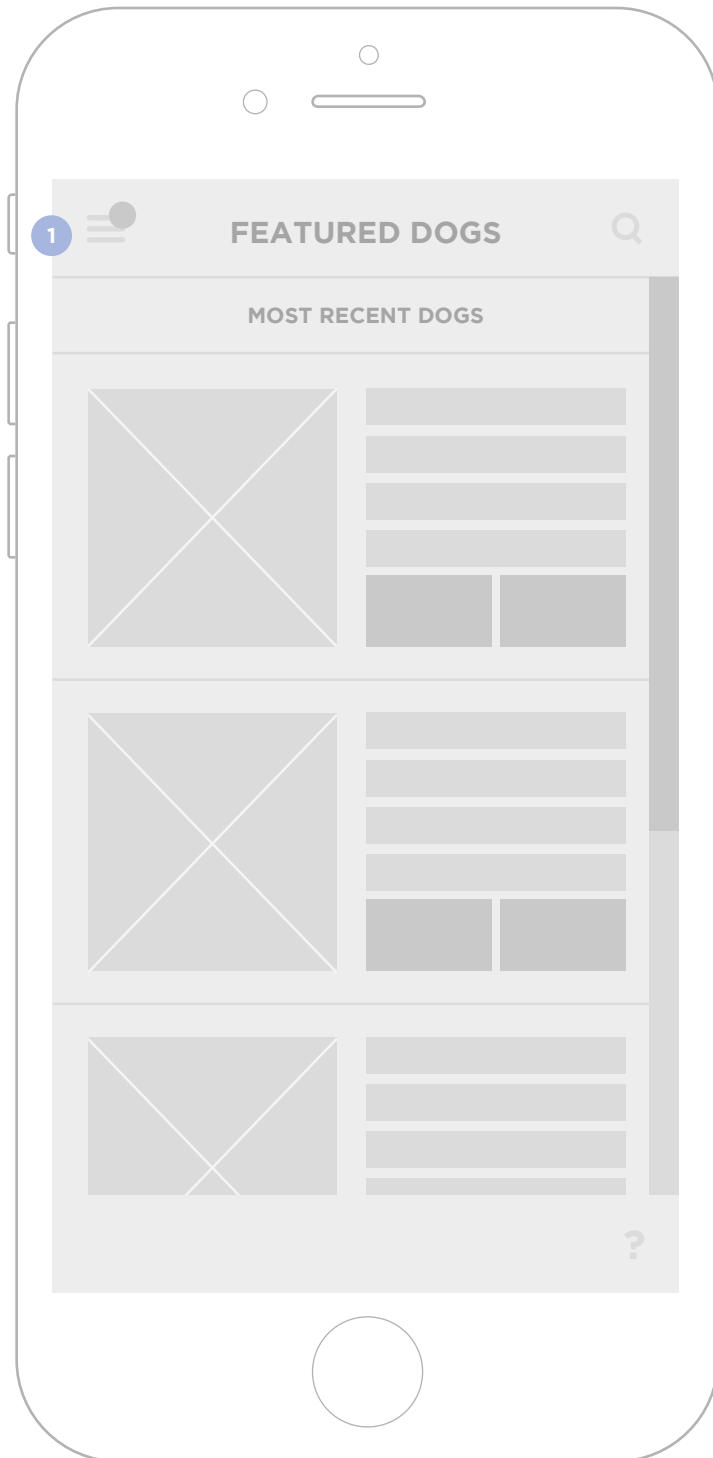
1 Confirmation message

2 The user can add this event to their calendar

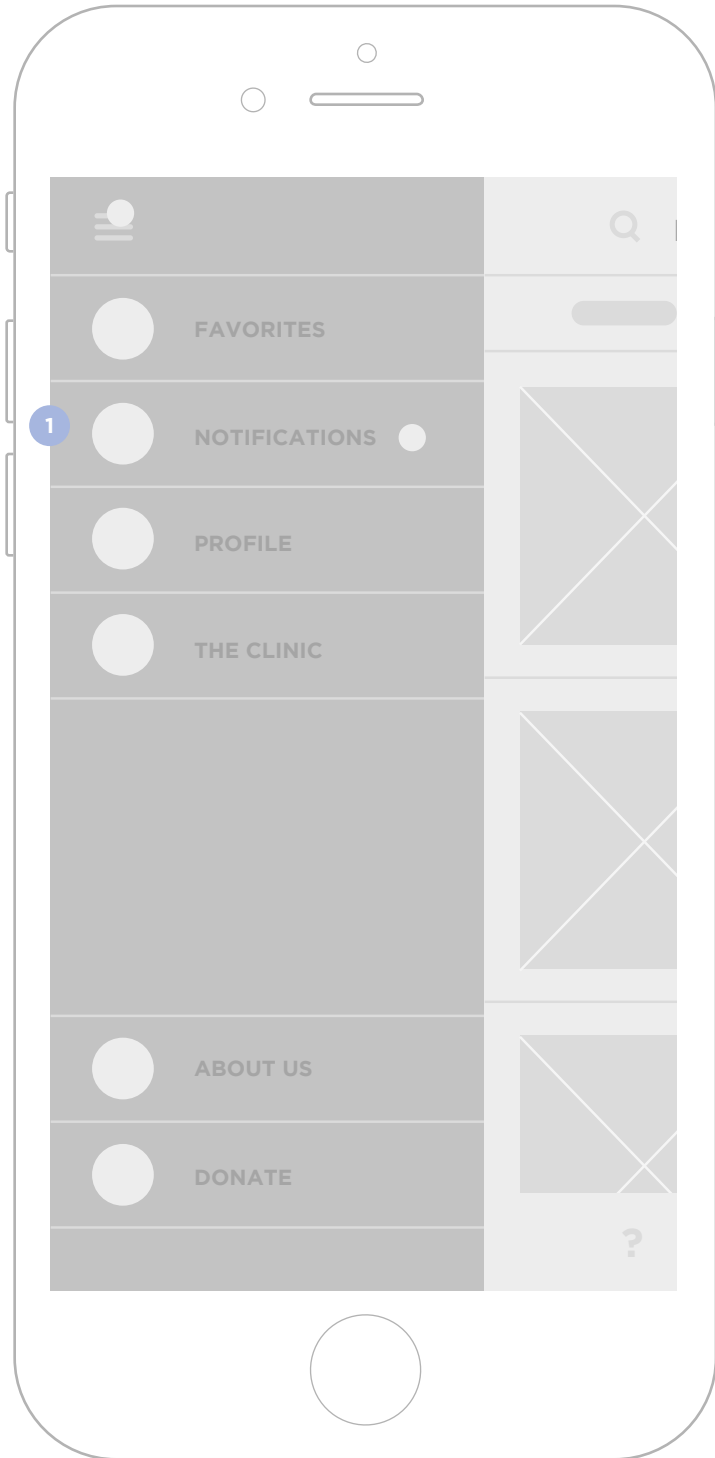
3 Next steps, user can click to know what are the next steps. This information is going to be in the confirmation email and notification too.

If the user skips this information, is still available in the confirmation email and notification.

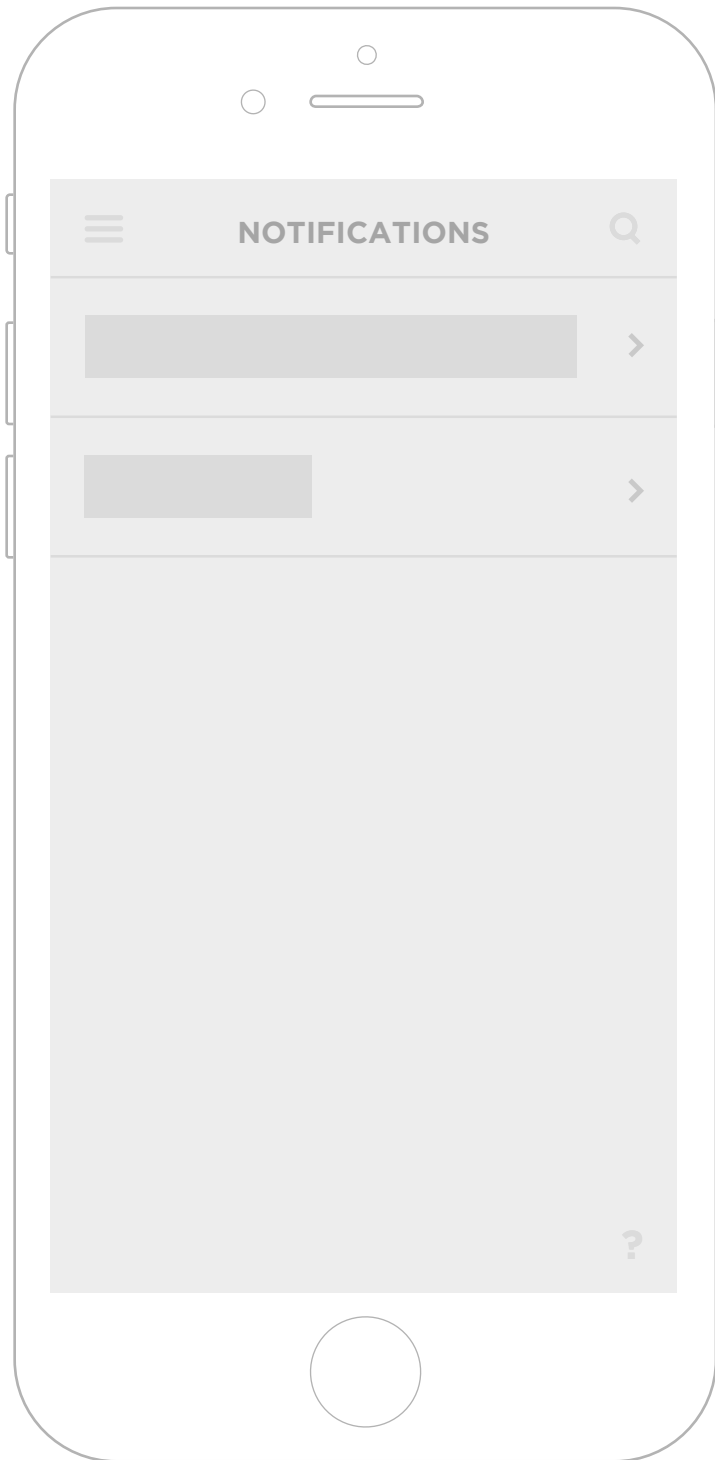




- 1 Menu icon shows a notification when you set an appointment.



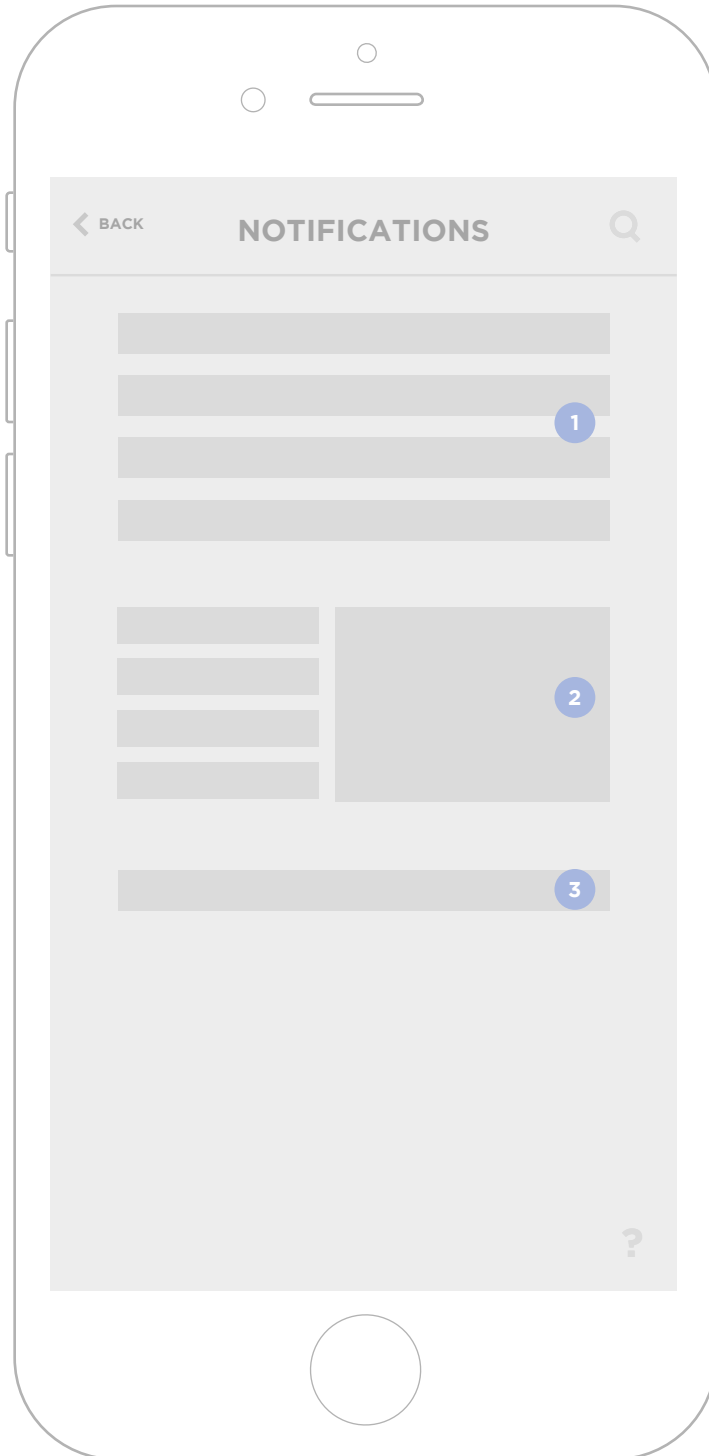
1 User can see notification count on the menu.

If you already adopted a dog it reminds you the vaccine and other important dates.

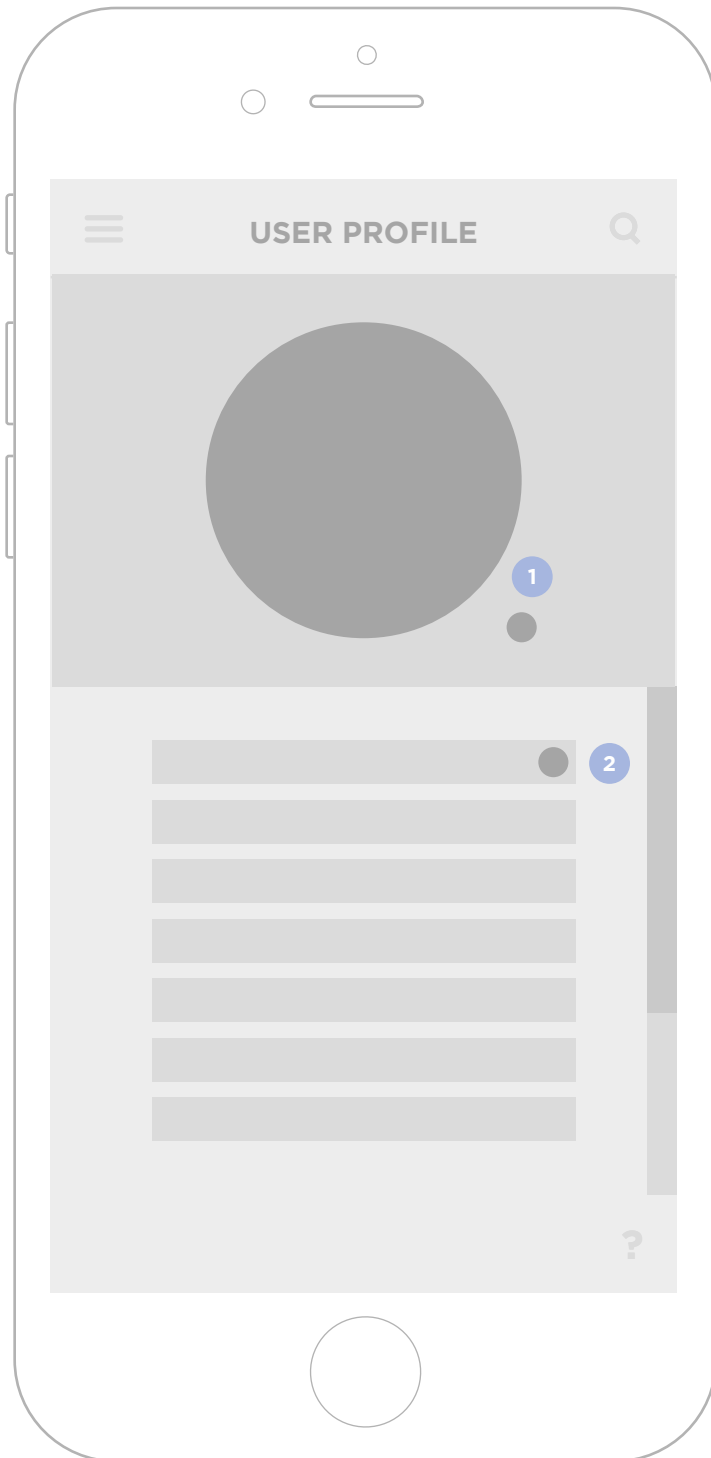
## NOTIFICATION OF AN APPOINTMENT



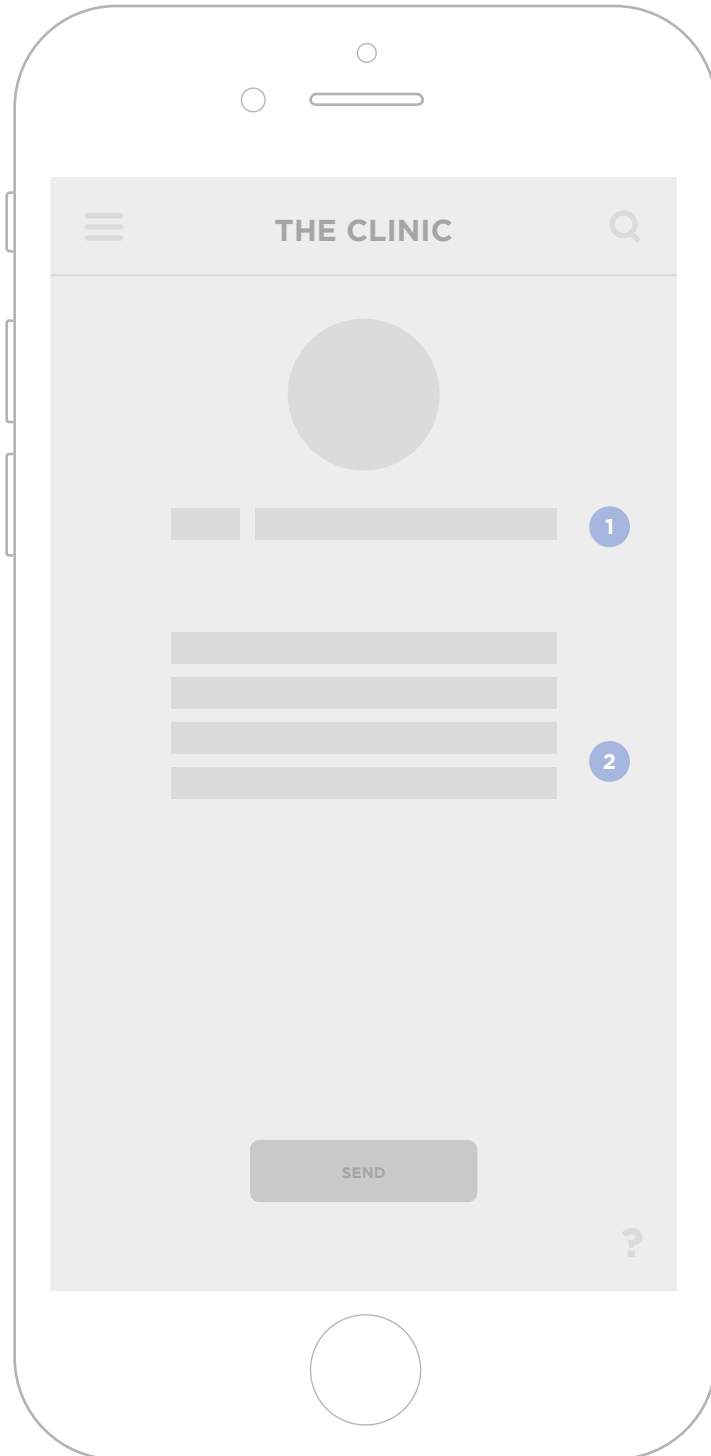
- 1 Date and time of the user's appointment.

- 3 Next steps information (Clickable).

  - What to bring.

\*If the user is not sure of the selected dog when he reaches the shelter, he can always come back to the app and check his favorites list to request to see another dog.

## USER'S PROFILE SCREEN



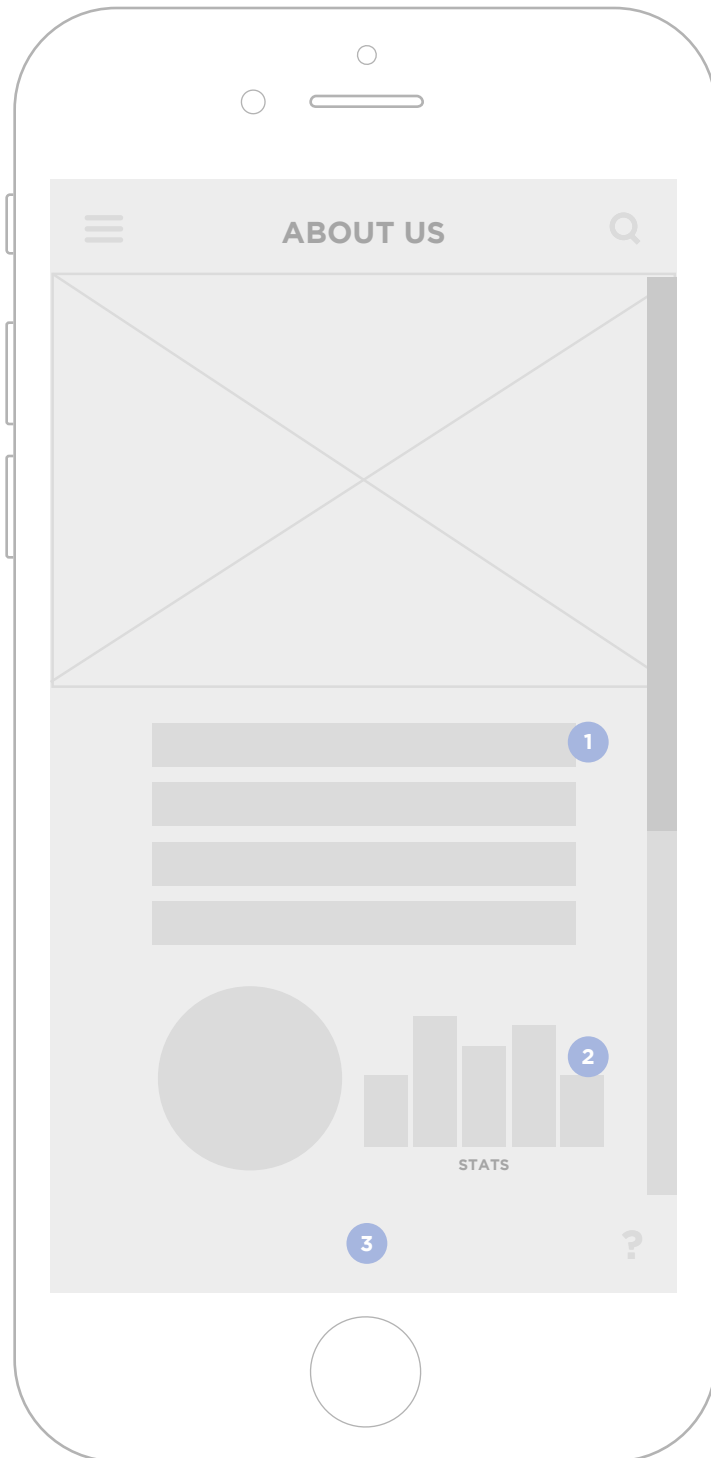
- 1 User's picture. Picture can be edited with the edit icon.
- 2 User's information. It can be updated by tapping edit.



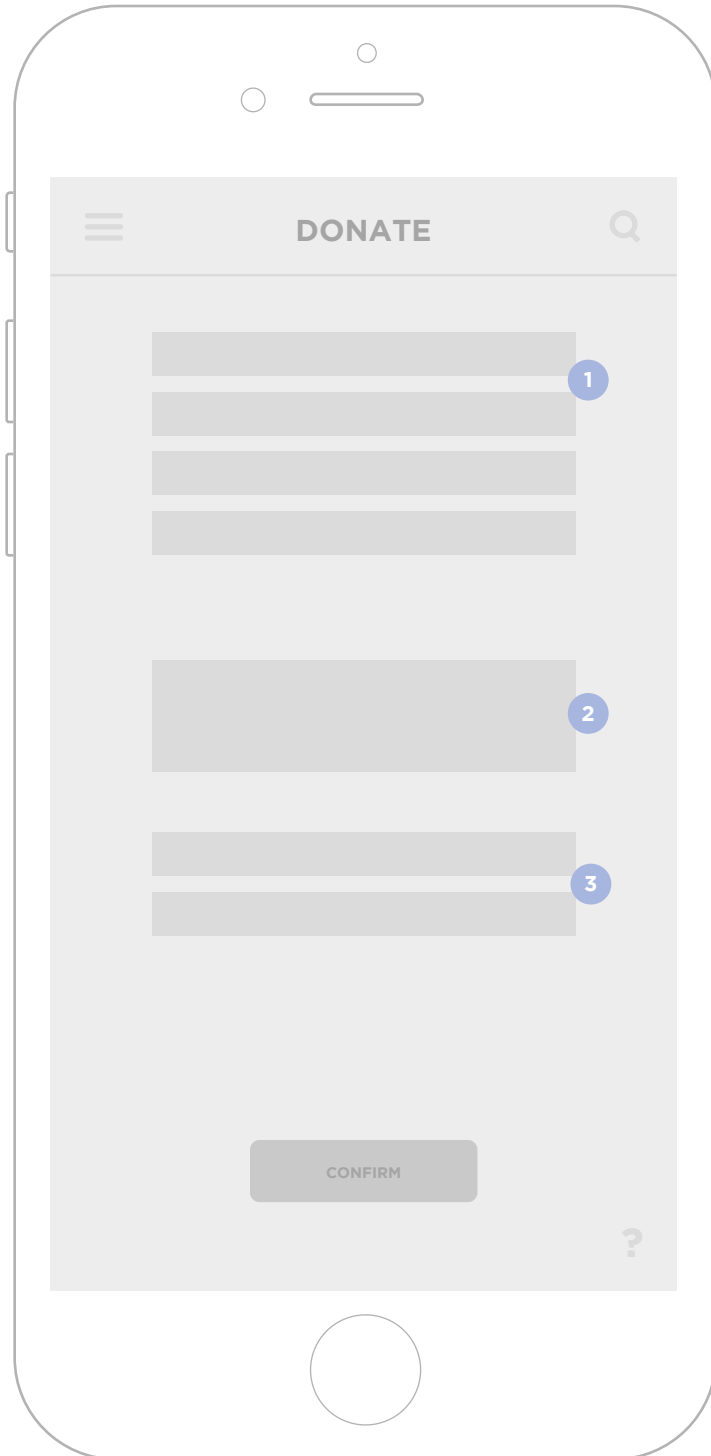
1 Emergency number, you can tap on it and it calls the clinic immediately in case of an emergency.
